FAQ Sheet

When and where?

Monday, March 6th, 2017 at Peterson Elementary School

Is there a fee to register?

No.

Are students going to be judged?

No, however they will be expected to answer questions from volunteer “judges” such as:

What is the title of your project?

What did you think would happen?

Did you repeat the experiment?

What was your control?

*The judges for 4th and 5th grade will provide feedback on the project if the student wishes. This is encouraged to help prepare them for middle school.

Do the students have to make a Tri-Fold?

No they don't. However it is encouraged.

Where can I get more information?

You can also contact any of the Science Fair Volunteers. The Peterson LMC will also have books displayed starting in December with project ideas and guides.

Will the fair be just the exhibits?

How are kids going to be recognized for their efforts?

Each child will receive a special surprise for participating as well as individual “judge” attention the night of the fair.

Do students have to participate to attend?
